
**TOXIC SUBSTANCE CONTROL ACT – IMPORT CERTIFICATION FORM FOR FORMALDEHYDE

The U.S. EPA issued a final rule to implement the Formaldehyde Standards for Composite Wood Products Act, which added Title VI to the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA). The purpose of TSCA Title VI is to reduce formaldehyde emissions from composite wood products. TSCA Title VI requires that composite wood products be tested and certified, ensuring only compliant products enter the product supply chain.
